

Asking Questions in Plain Form

★ **The 1st way** is if there is a question word in the sentence, eg: 何、だれ etc.
You simply add 「の？」 after the Plain Form Verb.

Translate these sentences into English:

1. 今、何するの？
2. あした、どこ行くの？

Translate these sentences into Japanese:

1. What will you buy?.....
2. Why are you going out?

★ **The 2nd way** is if there is no question word used. In this case, の is also not used. In its spoken form, you use inflection instead.

Translate these sentences into English:

1. 映画見に行く？
2. この漢字わかる？

Translate these sentences into Japanese:

1. When do you normally wake up?
2. What will you eat at the restaurant?
